# St Leonards Primary School Uniform

St Leonards Primary School Uniform is endorsed by School Governing Council. The current uniform was introduced following extensive consultation with parents, students and the school community. Factors of suitability, appearance, durability, washability and price were considered when recommending these items. The Uniform Committee meets regularly to review the uniform and may recommend additions or amendments to the approved items.

There is an expectation from Governing Council that all students will wear correct uniform to school. If students are unable to wear uniform on a particular day a note from parents/caregivers is required. Students will be given the opportunity to borrow uniform or sit out of play time.

Our students are continually on show as they play in the yard, go about their school day, go out of the school on excursions and even walk or ride to and from school. Therefore all parents are asked to check that their child's uniform is in good condition, including the green broad rimmed hat. In keeping with the principles of social justice, the Principal may arrange for the uniform items be made available to parents in extenuating circumstances. Parents and or staff should contact the Principal to discuss the situation.

A Uniform Shop is available at the school - please check with office staff for times. New and second hand uniform sales and enquires are conducted at times to suit our volunteer coordinator/s. Orders may be left with office staff and collected at a later time.

## Why a school uniform?

There are many reasons for having a school uniform, such as allowing our students to:-

- identify with the school
- demonstrate pride in themselves and the school
- feel part of a team (compare with sports/work uniform)
- prepare for High School/work where uniforms are required
- be easily identified at school (for safety) or on excursions
- support a good school image and develop self discipline
- prevent competition with other students about clothing (uniforms can be the cheapest form of clothing)
- make it easier for parents each morning to decide what their children should wear.

## Hats

Are compulsory during Terms 1 and 4 (no hat, no play) and optional in Terms 2 and 3. Broad brimmed hats, which shade all parts of the head, are to be worn (available with logo). Bucket hats, torn or defaced hats are not acceptable.

## Shoes

We would encourage children to wear comfortable school shoes, running shoes or sandals which allow the students to safely participate in all school activities, including PE classes. Examples of inappropriate shoes for PE are ballet flats, thongs, slip-ons and heeled shoes. Where possible, please ensure the colours are neutral. Changes became effective as of Term 1, 2014.

## Please remember

- That denim, black or grey clothing is not part of the school uniform. Designer label windcheaters or patterned t-shirts are not school wear items.
- For safety reasons: No necklaces, dangling earrings and chokers (unless for religious reasons after negotiations with the Principal), and no make up.
- To label all items of clothing.

## Year 7 Jumper/Polo Shirt

The Year 7 jumper/polo shirt is designed each year and available for purchase.

## Casual Clothing Days

Throughout the school year, some days are identified as Casual Clothes Day. These days are advertised in the schools newsletter. Often these days are held to raise money either for the school or charities. Sensible shoes must be worn and tops/dresses must have sleeves as per Sun Smart Policy.
