## 2. Maths: Focus on number, time, money or measurement

Students are currently developing their number sense, particularly place value, as well as learning about time. The focus is more on measuring time than telling the time as young children have trouble with understanding the passing of time. They need to learn about the seasons, months, weeks, days, hours etc. To do this they could look at calendars on a regular basis, watch videos about the seasons and use timers. They could get timed doing everyday activities Eg How long does it take to brush your teeth or shower? Or get them to do an activity for a minute and try to guess when a minute is up.
